VA | WAKE COUNTY VA OUTPATIENT CLINIC

CONSTRUCTION COST: \$200m PROJECT SIZE: 245,000 SF

Located in Raleigh, NC this new two-story, 245,000 SF facility includes the latest technology to assist in outpatient care. Major departments include Primary Care, Pharmacy, Canteen, Radiology, Pathology and Lab, Psychosocial Rehabilitation Recovery Center, Pulmonary Medicine and Speech-Language Pathology Patient Clinic. The new clinic was designed as a modern, high-performance medical office building that integrates and optimizes energy efficiency, durability, and life-cycle performance, while providing a welcoming environment for Veterans.



DOD | 1ST CAVALRY HEADQUARTERS

CONSTRUCTION COST: \$49.8m PROJECT SIZE: 135,800 SF

This three-foot and 135,800 SF building is a headquarters and command operations facility for the United States Army in Fort Hood, Texas. The facility, a design-build project, provides facilities to accommodate 1st Cavalry Division headquarters and command operations. It is intended to be similar to a combination corporate headquarters or municipal administration facility and an emergency operations center in the civilian sector community.



NAVFAC | NAVY RESERVE FORCE FALLON

CONSTRUCTION COST: \$14.4m PROJECT SIZE: 21,062 SF

The 21,062 SF P-III Navy Operational Support Center Project provides space for Navy Reserve Force personnel to train for a full range of peace and warfighting operations. The entire building can house a total occupancy of 126 personnel at one time. The administrative space was designed for occupancy of 10 full-time staff. Separate work areas and individual offices were provided to accommodate six separate functioning Naval Reserve Units. One of the units provides for medical services, including physician and dental care, blood draw, and urine analysis.
